Johnny Davis made a motion to approve payroll for the month of May. Carl Simon seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

Beckham County Rural Water Dist. #3 presented application for permit utility/service crossing to the Board of County Commissioners. Location: Merritt Road roadway approximately 1056 feet north from the SE corner of Section 23, Township 11N Range 22W. Johnny Davis made a motion to approve the utility crossing permit. Carl Simon seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

Chesapeake Midstream Gas Services, LLC presented application for gas carrying underground pipeline crossing facility. Proposed crossing will be located within the following legal description; between NW/4 of Sec 19-11N-23W and SW/4 of Sec 18-11N-23W (CR E1100). Chesapeake also agrees to pay \$500.00 application fee. Carl Simon made the motion to approve the application for crossing. Johnny Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

Janette Cornelius sold the following county property: Lincoln Park Addition Block 1 Lots 6 & 7 Elk City, OK. Amount bid was \$200.00 by Terry Jackson. Carl Simon made a motion to approve the sale of county property. Johnny Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

The Commissioners discussed the property at 1101 S. Randall, Elk City, District #2 facility. In order to sale this property at public auction a street and alley needs to be closed. Carl Simon made the motion for the county to hire an attorney that can complete the legal process of street closing. Johnny Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

The Commissioners discussed the report they received from ACCO insurance coverage on all the county owned property. Commissioners agreed the value needs to be raised on several properties, but they need time to research what would be the proper amounts. This item will be on agenda May 31st.
