Motion made by Carl Simon to approve cash fund estimate of needs and request for appropriation for Sheriff, Transfer of appropriations for Extension Office. Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

Motion made by Carl Simon to solicit phone bids for unleaded & diesel fuel for District #1, diesel fuel for District #3. Johnny Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

Motion made by Johnny Davis to publish County estimate of needs for FY 11-12. Carl Simon seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

Motion made by Carl Simon to approve the following requisition officers and receiving officers for FY 11-12. Johnny Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

The Board discussed implementing an application and permit fee (\$500) to work within Beckham County Highway System, right of way (entrance). Carl Simon made a motion to approve the application and permit fee effective 8/15/11. Johnny Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

**Resolution #11-47** Beckham County Board of Commissioners have adopted standard for access drive construction with respect to drive location, width, turning radius, surface material and storm water drainage requirements. Prior to construction of any access drive a permit shall be secured from the Beckham County Board of Commissioners. The request for such access drive permits shall be accompanied by a drawing showing the location of the proposed access drive, vehicle use, drive dimensions, drainage pipe (area opening and length). At the time of filling the application a non-refundable inspection to help defray County costs of inspecting the installation to determine

compliance with County regulations shall be paid to the County Commissioners office in the amount of (\$500) for each proposed drive to be constructed. Residential and Agricultural access drives to be constructed shall not be assessed a permit fee even though permits must be secured. No future permits shall be issued until all costs, damage repair and other requirements of these rules and regulations have been met to the satisfaction of the Beckham County Board of Commissioners. Motion made by Carl Simon to approve Resolution #11-47 effective 8/15/11. Johnny Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

Beckham County was awarded a Safety Award from Association of County Commissioner of Oklahoma at the summer conference. The award included a check for \$1,000.00. Carl Simon made a motion to deposit award to general government account. Johnny Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.

No unfinished business to be discussed.

Louise Schulz, 4 D Acquistion/ONEOK representative discussed with County Commissioners their pipeline project. They are requesting permission to cross under the road with the minimum 5' below ditch line and minimum 6' below road bed. These are the minimums so if in an area it was needed to go deeper because of erosion they would go deeper. The County permit is 8' under the ditch line. The Commissioners discussed safety issues and agreed the 8' under the ditch line would remain the acceptable depth as stated in permit.

Motion made by Carl Simon to adjourn. Johnny Davis seconded the motion with Campbell, Simon and Davis voting aye.
