Motion made by Carl Don Campbell to approve July payroll. Carl Simon seconded the motion with Simon and Campbell voting aye.

Sheriff Scott Jay explained the contract for services with Nathan Brewer as Sheriff's Office Media Coordinator. Contract will be effective July 16th, 2012 through June 30th, 2013 at a rate of \$400.00 a month. Last week the Board voted to deny this contract. Carl Don Campbell made a motion to resign

last week's vote and a motion to approve the contract. Carl Simon seconded the motion with Simon and Campbell voting aye.

Resolution #12-35 Whereas the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials has designated a corridor known as Route 66 beginning in Illinois and terminating in California to be developed as United States Bike Route 66 (USBR 66). Beckham County Commissioners hereby expresses it approval and support for the development of USBR 66, and requests that the appropriate officials see to it that the route is officially designated by AASHTO as soon as this can be achieved, and authorizes the posting of signs when available or appropriate within the Beckham County right-of-way identifying the route through the community once the official designation has been made. Carl Don Campbell made a motion to adopt resolution #12-35 effective July 23, 2012. Carl Simon seconded the motion with Simon and Campbell voting aye.

Resolution #12-36 It is the desire and intention of the Board of Beckham County Commissioners to close county road NS1990, EW1310 to the Greer Co. line in District #2. Carl Don Campbell made a motion to adopt resolution #12-36 effective July 23, 2012. Carl Simon seconded the motion with Simon and Campbell voting aye.

Lonnie Risenhoover discussed with the Board the liability insurance for the County owned fire trucks. Purchasing the coverage and providing the County proof of coverage is each cities responsibility. Lonnie has visited with the city officials and will maintain the proof of coverage on behalf of the County.
