The Board reviewed agreement between Health Department and Great Plains Regional Medical Center for fiscal year 2014-2015. Motion made by Johnny Davis to approve agreement. Buddy Carnes seconded the motion with Campbell, Carnes and Davis voting aye.

Advanced Correction Healthcare Program provides inmate medical care to county/city jails. Art Rose, Consultant, said their goal is to ensure the inmates medical needs are addressed as required by law so their health is not allowed to decline. This means they get what they need, but not always what they want. Three

doctors are on call 24/7, and ACH employ nurses that are on-site. They attempt to employ local medical personnel when possible. Motion made by Johnny Davis to table this proposal giving the Board time to study the proposal.
