WRIT OF GENERAL EXECUTION

THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA, TO THE SHERIFF OF BECKHAM COUNTY, IN SAID STATE, GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the above-named Plaintiff and Judgment Creditor, BMO Harris Bank N.A., obtained a judgment that was filed on the 23rd day of March, 2022, in the above-styled case, CV-2022-26, against the above-named Defendant and Judgment Debtor, Resistol Services LLC, for damages in the sum of \$720,138.46, together with \$21,984.00 in costs and fees, interest thereon in the amount of \$102,452.18 as of the date of judgment, plus interest at accruing the rate prescribed by 28 U.S.C. § 1961 on said damages from and after March 23, 2022, until paid.

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid judgment has not been fully paid and satisfied, and the amount owed on said judgment, with accrued interest, to the above-named Plaintiff and Judgment Creditor, is \$844,574.64 as of March 23, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, YOU ARE HEREBY COMMANDED to satisfy the amount currently owed on the judgment by taking into your possession and selling the nonexempt personal property of the aforesaid Defendant and Judgment Debtor, Resistol Services LLC, up to the

amount that is sufficient to satisfy the amount currently owed on the judgment. If the personal property you are able to find is not sufficient to satisfy the amount currently owed on the judgment, you are directed to satisfy the balance currently owed on the judgment by execution and sale of all nonexempt real property of the aforesaid Defendant and Judgment Debtor up to the amount that is sufficient to satisfy the amount currently owed on the judgment. If you are unable to find any personal property of the aforesaid Defendant and Judgment Debtor, you are directed to endorse this Writ of General Execution with "No Goods," and then satisfy the amount currently owed on the judgment by execution and sale of all nonexempt real property of the aforesaid Defendant and Judgment Debtor up to the amount that is sufficient to satisfy the amount currently owed on the judgment.


